

## **ALL YOU WANT TO KNOW ABOUT PG DIPLOMA IN FINANCIAL MARKETS PRACTICE**

### **What is the course all about?**

The course is about gaining knowledge and skills in all segments of financial markets.

### **What is the duration of the course?**

The duration of the course is one year. However, the candidate can complete the course in an extended period of two years.

### **What is the course fee?**

The fee for the course is Rs 10,000.

### **Will there be contact classes or will it be totally in correspondence mode ?**

The course is being offered in the distance learning /correspondence mode. IGNOU, however, arranges for counselling and interactive sessions through radio and Doordarshan's educational channel. The details are available in the prospectus.

### **Will there be any practical exposure to financial markets practice in Course 5?**

There will be no practical /hands-on exposure in Course 5.

### **Is there any sequential order for studying the courses or can I attempt even the last course first?**

First four courses will be offered in the first semester and 5th course will be in the second semester.

### **Where can I obtain the prospectus and the brochures and what is the mode of payment?**

You can get full information about the course from the Regional Centre of IGNOU nearest to you or from the main centre of IGNOU in Delhi.

### **Where should I submit the completed application form?**

You can submit the completed application form at any of the Regional Centres of IGNOU.

### **What is the maximum time limit to complete the course?**

The course is of one-year duration, but it can be extended up to a maximum of two years.

### **If I am not able to complete the course in the stated time, will there be any extension of time ?**

You can complete the course in the maximum time frame of two years. You can even extend the period beyond two years by paying a re-enrolment fee based on the semesters already completed.

### **When can I appear for the exam?**

IGNOU holds the examination twice a year, in June and December.

### **Is there any provision for re-appearing for the exam?**

The candidate has to complete the entire course of two semesters within two years.

### **What are the job prospects after the course?**

You will get adequate knowledge on Indian financial markets, which will make you competent enough to get job opportunities in broking firms, corporate s, banks, etc.

**When will the candidate get the course material?**

Course material will be distributed in January - February 2010.

**What will be the examination pattern?**

It will be totally subjective.

**Can the candidate pay online or through credit card?**

No credit card or online payment facility is available. Candidate can pay through DD in favour of 'IGNOU'.
